The website www.smart-e.co.uk is owned and operated by Smart-e (UK) Ltd. Smart-e (UK) Ltd is the controller of all personal information collected on this website. Smart-e (UK) Ltd is committed to ensuring that your privacy is protected. Should we ask you to provide certain information by which you can be identified, you can be assured that it will only be used in accordance with this privacy statement and the new GDPR data protection regulations. This Privacy Statement sets out the basis on which any personal data we collect from you, or that you provide to us, will be processed by us. Please read the following carefully to understand our views and practices regarding your personal data and how we will treat it.

What information do we collect on you:

We may also use this data to carry out our obligations arising from any contracts entered between you and Smarte (UK) Ltd. In such case the legal basis is Article 6 (1) (b) GDPR.

We may also collect the above noted information in person at trade shows and exhibitions. Information gained from the exchange of business cards or email addresses with potential customers, customers, show/exhibition organisers, exhibiting companies and industry press is stored on our system and falls under the processing and consent policy seen above.

if you have provided your consent for the use of your data for marketing purposes, we will contact you by electronic means (e-mail) or by direct mail with information about goods and services like those which were the subject of such consent. The legal basis for this processing is Article 6 (1) (a) GDPR.

What do we use your information for:

Retention Period & Your Rights:

We will retain your personal information for the period necessary to fulfil the purposes outlined in this Privacy Statement unless a longer retention period is required or permitted by applicable law.

As a data subject, you have the right to assert the rights of the data subject vis-à-vis us at any time. In particular, you have the following rights:

- You have the right to obtain information whether and if applicable to which extent we process personal data concerning you or not.
- In the case of processing of personal data concerning you, you have the right to access information, in particular, the following information: stored data concerning you, purpose(s) of the

- You have the right to let the processing of your personal data be restricted.
- You have the right to receive the personal data concerning you which you had provided to us in a structured, standard and machine-readable format, and to transmit these data to another controller.

Cookies:

Smart-e (UK) Ltd does not provide on-line shopping and e-billing services. Smart-e (UK) Ltd uses traffic log cookies to identify which pages are being used. This helps us analyse data about web page traffic and improve our website in order to tailor it to customer needs. We use this information for statistical analysis purposes only and the the data is then removed from the system. Smart-e (UK) Ltd uses Google Analytics, which measures how users interact with website content, such as what device and browser they are

using. Google Analytics uses cookies to "remember" what a user has done on previous pages and interactions with the website. Cookies do not store any personally identifiable information, such as your name, address or any financial information.
